Third Sunday of Lent February 28, 2016



Dear parishioners,

Once again we are blessed with a catechumen "Elect" preparing to be baptized at Easter. When this is true, a parish uses the readings of Year A rather than the expected year. Today the readings are about water.

In the first reading the Israelites grumble against Moses because they have no water. This is more than grumbling against Moses. They are really grumbling against God. God has freed them from the slavery of Egypt, has led them with a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night, and has provided them with manna and quail. They are not trusting God to continue to take care of them. Through Moses God <u>again</u> shows the people that God is true to the promises made and God will and does take care of them.

In the gospel Jesus engages a Samaritan woman about water. She understands him on a literal plane and hears him speaking literally about water. Jesus is speaking about pouring his divine life into her. She eventually comes to realize that he is speaking to her about the supernatural.

So we reflect on the fact that all of us who are baptized share in God's divine life. We don't see it or feel it, but we believe it. We believe in its power.

So we pray today and through Lent for ourselves and for Tori that we might all become more aware of the marvelous gift that is given to us.
