Dear parishioners,

Building a building and waging a war are both difficult, costly, and lengthy endeavors. You give a lot of thought to entering that kind of project. Being a disciple of Jesus is also difficult, costly, and lengthy. Jesus didn't trick us into membership. He tells us over and over: "Whoever does not carry his cross and come after me cannot be my disciple."

Although giving our life to Jesus and Jesus' service does bring a deep sense of joy and peace, Jesus never promised us that being his disciple would make life easy and we'd always feel really good.

A couple of us went to a workshop this week, and we were told that sin is contagious. Sociologists have learned that when something easy, lazy, pride-filled, ego-building begins to happen in society, it doesn't take long before people rationalize it to be "good." They gave the example of abortion which is always evil, but which we in our country have rationalized to be "good" because it "protects" a mother's "right to choose" and so we have made it legal. We know deep down that even if something is legal it is not moral.

That's just one example of why the Christian life is difficult. It is hard to stand up for right when everyone around us is cheering for the other side. We may even be ridiculed for our belief.

We need the strength and mercy of God to count the cost and recommit to building the kingdom of God and waging war against evil.
