Lenten opportunities

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, February 10. There will be a Communion service with distribution of ashes at noon and Mass with distribution of ashes at 7:00 o'clock in the evening.

Every Wednesday during Lent we will have Stations of the Cross at 6:30 and Mass at 7:00. Every Thursday from 8:00-9:00 there will be opportunity for Adoration.

This Lent there will be no Penance service. There will be instead additional opportunities for private confession: before each Mass on Saturdays and Sundays, on Wednesdays, March 2 and March 16 from 5:00 to 6:30 (7:00) and after Mass until all who wish have received the sacrament.

As you know, there are two days of fasting for those between 18 and 59—Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. These two days and all the Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence (no meat) for those ages 14 through 59.

Lenten Small Groups--There's still time! Sign-up sheets are out in the main entrance.

Rite of Sending and Rite of Election Next Sunday, February 14, we will be celebrating the Rite of Sending with Tori Halcomb. This means the parish approves her request to become a member of the Catholic Church and we send her to a ceremony with the bishop where he will declare her among the "Elect" to be baptized at the Easter Vigil. Congratulations for coming to this point in your journey, Tori!
