Dear parishioners,

Pope Francis tells us we can't really appreciate and celebrate this Year of Mercy unless we recognize our sinfulness. We need to do works of mercy to extend God's mercy. We also need to recognize our own need for God's mercy.

David had done some really, really bad things: he committed adultery with Uriah's wife and then to save face for himself he had Uriah killed. Nathan the prophet spells it out for David. First he reminded David of all the great things God has done for David. Then Nathan recounts David's sins and asks him why he has spurned the Lord. David is humbled and sorry and immediately does penance. He is seeking God's mercy and forgiveness.

In the gospel we are introduced to "a sinful woman" who washes Jesus' feet with her tears, wipes them dry with her hair, kisses them, and anoints them with precious oil. The Pharisees are appalled—and self-righteous. Jesus sees the woman's heart, knows her sorrow, and forgives her. He lets go her past and sees her present.

To know God's mercy is to recount for ourselves our wrongs and shortcomings and to let contrition grow in our hearts. We also need to show God our hearts and ask for God's mercy and forgiveness. If we do this, we will be ready for the Extraordinary Year of Mercy.
