Dear parishioners,

Tomorrow I and 14 others begin our Year of Mercy pilgrimage to Italy. We will be staying at Sorrento, Assisi, and Rome. We will make day visits to the Isle of Capri, to Pompeii, and to Monte Cassino where St. Benedict began the Benedictine order. We will stay two nights in Assisi where St. Francis and St. Clare began the Franciscan order. Once in Rome we will visit and celebrate Mass at all of the major basilicas: St. Peter (where St. Peter is buried), St. Mary Major (the first church in Roman Catholicism dedicated to Mary and the largest church in the world dedicated to Mary), St. John Lateran (the Pope's cathedral), and St. Paul outside the Walls (where St. Paul is buried). We will walk through the holy doors. We will also have two opportunities to see Pope Francis. Please know that I will certainly pray for all of you at all those holy places and ask God to make of all of us good and faithful disciples—like Peter, Paul, Benedict, Francis, and Clare.

I want to thank you again for the wonderful trip to Italy that you gave me in 2011 which made come true several things on my bucket list and where I learned how this works so that others can enjoy this experience with me.

The places we visit will remind us of the history and endurance of our Church. Many of these churches have been around for hundreds of years—in some cases even more than a thousand. God has promised that God will be with us until the end of time. This is the proof.

I take you all with me in my memory and my heart.
