Dear parishioners,

I just want to update you about our solar research. Our purpose for looking into this is twofold: to lessen our carbon footprint (that is, to use fewer non-renewable natural resources and do less damage to the Earth) and to lessen our utility costs. Pope Francis in his encyclical "Laudato Si!" ("Be praised my Lord!") asks us to take seriously the care of the Earth. We have only one Earth. It's precious. Earth is mother to us all so we need to look, not merely at our own need, but at the needs of all peoples, especially the poor who are most affected by the damage done to the Earth.

The price tag is hefty so we want to look at this carefully to assure we do what is best. Following our Saturday and Sunday meetings Dan Klear has done more research to find answers to our questions. The shading from all the trees (that do not belong to us) reduces the panels' efficiency to 60%. The cost of a carport to support the solar panels would add \$45,000 to the cost. We are also looking at other energy reducing possibilities—solar lights at some places and LED lighting in church. Grants are available to support these efforts. Green Options, LLC, is preparing estimates and looking into whether we qualify for any grants.

I want to assure you that no decisions have been made. The Finance Council and I will be discussing this again at our next meeting. We want to look at all our needs and obligations before we move ahead with any such project. I will make my best effort to keep you informed.
